Baptismal preparation programme for older Children.

Sometimes it happens that children are not baptised in infancy.

Like last year the parish is delighted to offer a course for children that are five years or older and wish to be baptized. Parents who have children who wish to make First Communion and /or the Sacrament of Confirmation in the parish in the coming year, and are not yet baptised have to be prepared for baptism.

Last minute baptisms will not be possible before the First Communion time. So action is needed now.

This course will be offered only once a year and will include a few meetings with the children and their parent(s) / guardian(s).

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

will take place next Saturday 6th October after the 10am morning Mass.
