The drawings for some proposed alterations in St. Patrick's Church, including relocating the Baptismal Font and extending the choir gallery are on view at the back of the Church.

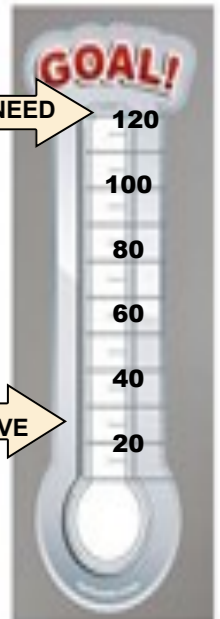
Drawings to re-locate the Tabernacle and the Altar to the centre in St. Brigid's Church and a new small meeting room are on view at the confessional.
