Child Protection in our Parish

Our parish is striving to develop a child centred culture: a church which is all-inclusive, welcoming and keen to promote the rights and best interests of all. It is our job to ensure the absolute protection of children from harm, and the right to participation in a safe environment.

Children can benefit greatly from participation in Church life. They should be encouraged to engage and participate as fully as possible in the liturgies and all church activities. They should be encouraged to be independent and become aware of their own rights and the rights of others in Church activities. Children need to be aware of appropriate boundaries and acceptable behaviour.

We have a clear and concise code of behaviour, which all clergy, religious, employees and volunteers sign up to, when then begin working in our parish. We ensure this is regularly reviewed; acceptable behaviour from our Church personnel which ensures that children feel safe and are safe. We have 2 Child Protection Volunteers in our parish, Margaret O'Shea and Maureen Giblin but ideally we would like another 2 people. Please give your name at the parish office if interested.

The parish is conducting an audit on Child Protection and have an Anti - Bullying policy in place. A copy is available at the back of the Church beside the bookstand.
