24 Hours for the Lord



Across the globe on the same day - 24 hours to realign our compass on the Lord Jesus Christ. Pope Francis states in Misericordiae Vultus - the Official Bull of Indiction of the Extraordinary Jubilee Year of Mercy, that he would like Friday 4th and Saturday 5th March to be set aside as "24 Hours for the Lord." "As individuals, we are tempted by indifference," he wrote. "Flooded with news reports and troubling images of human suffering, we often feel our complete inability to help. What can we do to avoid being caught up in this spiral of distress and powerlessness? "First, we can pray in communion with the Church on earth and in heaven," the Pope said. "Let us not underestimate the power of so many voices united in prayer!

Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament will take place in St Patrick's Church on Friday at 10.30am until before the 7pm evening Mass and on Saturday at 11am (after Mass and Sacrament of Reconciliation) until 5.45pm. A sheet will be available at the back of the Church for people to volunteer to give 1 hour in prayer in front of the Blessed Sacrament.

Housekeeping

In order to make our celebration of the Mass respectful & harmonious let us make our responses slowly, clearly and meaningfully.
 After the Homily there is to be a pause while the first collection is gathered. Only when it is completed should we profess the Creed. The second collection is taken up after the prayers of the faithful. Let us all be pro-active in passing the collection bags along.
 At Mass where Holy Communion is shared under both kinds, it is not permitted to 'Dip' the host, because Holy Communion is received not taken. Accessing Holy Communion is by going up the main aisle and always to return to your seat by the side aisle.
 During Mass one should not light shrine candles.
 If you are not taking the Mass leaflet home please return it to the holder at the door.
 Let us celebrate the Eucharist in prayerful union with each other.

Pope Francis' Prayer for the Year of Mercy
 Lord Jesus Christ, you have taught us to be merciful like the heavenly Father, and have told us that whoever sees you sees Him.
 Show us your face and we will be saved.
 Your loving gaze freed Zacchaeus and Matthew from being enslaved by money; the adulteress and Magdalene from seeking happiness only in created things; made Peter weep after his betrayal, and assured Paradise to the repentant thief.
 Let us hear, as if addressed to each one of us, the words that you spoke to the Samaritan woman: "If you knew the gift of God!"
 You are the visible face of the invisible Father, of the God who manifests his power above all by forgiveness and mercy: let the Church be your visible face in the world, its Lord risen and glorified.

 Send your Spirit and consecrate every one of us with its anointing, so that the Jubilee of Mercy may be a year of grace from the Lord, and your Church, with renewed enthusiasm, may bring good news to the poor, proclaim liberty to captives and the oppressed, and restore sight to the blind.
 We ask this through the intercession of Mary, Mother of Mercy, you who live and reign with the Father and the Holy Spirit for ever and ever Amen.
