**FAITH FOR LIFE**

**Nurturing the call received in Baptism..... Deepening the connection between Faith and Life. A course designed and delivered through a partnership agreement between the Archdiocese of Dublin and Liverpool.**

In The Joy of the Gospel Pope Francis tells us: "The Gospel is not merely about our personal relationship with God. The Gospel is about the kingdom of God; To the extent that God reigns within us, the life of society will be a settling for universal fraternity, justice, peace and dignity. The way we live as Christians is meant to have an impact on society"

It is a course to help you discover more energising and empowering ways to live out your faith in the reality of today's world: through relationships in family, parish, workplace; and the events of daily life.

It aims to help you become more open, confident, trusting and willing to work for change. Faith for Life is experienced in a journey of four movements which will help participants to explore and deepen the call received in Baptism.

Each of the four Movements requires: 12 hours of group activities, including facilitated conversations, input, personal and group reflection, prayer and liturgy.

**An Adult Faith Development Programme in Clonliffe College**

Have you ever thought about exploring your faith ..... or wished that you could broaden your understanding of your faith ..... found yourself longing to search for some kind of deeper meaning in life? ... perhaps you are you feeling challenged by questions your children or grandchildren are asking about God and the meaning of faith for which you feel you have 'no answers' ... perhaps you are feeling challenged by all that is happening in Ireland and in the Church right now. If so, Pathways may be the course for you.

Pathways is a two-year one night a week course for adults who wish to explore their faith. It runs from mid-September to May each year. There are no exams and no written work. The only requirement is an openness to listening to others and to participate. You can just come along and enjoy! The cost is €400 for the coming academic year. Booking is now open. The programme begins this year in Clonliffe College in September 2016.
