Faith for Life is experienced in a journey of four movements which will help participants to explore and deepen the call received in Baptism.

Each of the four Movements requires: 12 hours of group activities, including facilitated conversations, input, personal and group reflection, prayer and liturgy. 2 or 3 meetings in local groups arranged between each Movement. Letter from Diarmuid Martin Archbishop of Dublin

The Church is very lucky to have Pope Francis. He is calling for renewal across the Church. That call is addressed in the first place to each of us personally. His personal style, his simplicity of life, and his boundless energy for a man of his age appeal to all.

On the other hand, Pope Francis is not afraid to upset those who have become trapped in a Church of habit. He is not attempting to change the teaching of the Church. But he wants a Church which is out in the world in service and in dialogue. He does not want a fearful Church obsessed just with the evils of the world. He does not want a Church in which we try to keep Jesus locked up within our own categories. He wants a Church which will win the hearts of men and women in our time to understand and embrace the message of Jesus Christ.

Today we take up the "Peter's Pence Collection", one of the oldest collections in Church history, a tradition in which the Church worldwide supports the charitable and evangelical work of the Bishop of Rome. Hopefully you will give generously to this collection as a sign of gratitude and recognition of the work of Pope Francis.

We pray for the Pope and we pray that his work will lead each of us towards authentic renewal in our faith.
