This is the year of Consecrated Life proclaimed by Pope Francis and started in Advent 2014. The variety of religious congregations and groups in the life of the Catholic Church is a great blessing. Some religious communities are monastic type communities devoting themselves to pray and living the Christian life. Others were established to undertake particular works of service in local Churches such as education and care of the sick. Other congregations have as their main focus missionary work. In our parish we have four religious congregations present. The Salesians, Sisters of the Holy Family of Bordeaux, Sisters of the Holy Faith, Saint John of God Hospitaller Ministries. Over the next few weeks we will highlight their history and their works.

**The Salesian's of Don Bosco**

Founded in 1859 by Saint John Bosco, there are currently 15,560 members (priests and brothers) in the Salesian Congregation, working in 131 countries around the world. In the past few years new works have been undertaken in Azerbaijan, Iraq, Kuwait, Mauritius and Mongolia. As well as the Society of St. Francis de Sales, John Bosco also founded the Institute of the Daughters of Mary Help of Christians (Salesian Sisters), and the Association of Salesian Co-operators.

The Salesian's are dedicated to the Catholic education of youth with the family spirit of reason, religion and loving kindness, they provide a secondary school for boys on the Maynooth Road, Celbridge since 1981. In Ireland the Salesian's are engaged in media and publishing, hostels, secondary, agricultural and horticultural colleges, parishes, youth centres and clubs, chaplaincies (post primary, university, armed forces and hospital) and a series of Don Bosco Homes in Dublin's inner city.
