A gentle reminder and good housekeeping

- We should always be aware of the example we give in the Church, especially to a person who is a stranger visiting or a person curious and seeking perhaps faith.
- All of us need to make a conscious effort to be punctual.
- While Mass is being celebrated you should not light candles at any shrines. Wait till Mass is over.
- Mass ends when the celebrant, servers and ministers leave the church.
- Movement should be minimized when we are praying so as to not distract people.
- Due to privacy and data laws no recording should be made during worship.
- When receiving Holy Communion from the chalice you remain standing.
- The first collection (blue bags) is taken up after the Homily during the reading of notices, the second (red bag) at the offertory.

Renovations Appeal

In every generation improvements were made to our parish facilities as needs changed and the population of the parish increased. I thank you for your financial support of the parish. However, we now need to enhance our church facilities.

St. Patrick's Celbridge

The choir gallery needs to be extended and a new stairway erected up to it for health and safety.

The baptismal font will be relocated halfway down the church.

A new Reconciliation Room will be put in place.

The flooring around the altar may be done in marble tiles.

The total cost will be €235,000 - including 13% VAT.

St. Brigid's Straffan

Lower the sanctuary by one step

Re-centre the present altar and tile floor and move new tabernacle to centre of the altar area.

Install new limestone lectern/ambo for readings and new baptism font in similar material.

New gas mains boiler etc.

Build a new gathering space with toilets and small kitchen facility which can accommodate overflow congregation at funerals and provide a safe space for children's liturgy of the word.

The total cost will be €306,000 - including 13% VAT.

Contributions given to particular appeal will be used exclusively for that Church.

Renovation appeal **white** envelopes for Straffan Church.

Renovation appeal **green** envelopes for Celbridge Church.

In order to proceed with the works the Diocese requires us to have 80% of the cost pledged or to hand.

I am appealing for your support of the project. There are a number of options or combination of support for these capital works.

- A donation would be appreciated.
- To pay €25 per month for 2 years by direct debit.
- To lend €1000 or €500 to the parish to fund the work for three years after which your loan will be repaid to you.
